EMPTY HOLDING TANKS FOR MARINE HEAD – all waste tanks must be emptied before being stored. Southampton Town offers Free Pumpouts on VHF channel 73 you must be present at pumpout. Any waste tanks not emptied will be done by marina & billed at \$600. *I understand there is free pumpout available _____ Initials.

REMOVE PERSONAL ITEMS/RENEW INSURANCE – Hampton Watercraft & Marine is not responsible for personal items left on boat (fishing rods, water skis etc) Please remove all. Hampton Watercraft & Marine is not responsible for any damage due to fire, theft, accident or any cause beyond their control. Please make sure your insurance is current. (IMPORTANT – see #2 and #4 under Terms and Conditions on back).

SECURE YOUR BOAT PROPERLY- Most damage occurs in fall season when boats are not used as often. Please make an effort to drop your boat off early to protect it. **Pick up and delivery will be billed accordingly.**

PAYMENT SCHEDULE – Packages are billed in three invoices to spread out the costs. We perform the majority of work in the fall to ensure a timely spring delivery. The winterization and storage & winter services are invoiced in fall and due net 15 days. Spring Make Ready, Zincs and bottom paint are invoiced on January 1st due January 16th. Cleaning and gas is billed at Spring Launch. **ALL INVOICES WILL BE SENT ELECTRONICALLY.** All boats that have previously been bottom painted will be re-painted. Hampton Watercraft & Marine will evaluate props, send out for reconditioning if needed and bill accordingly. Hampton Watercraft & Marine has authority to perform additional repairs up to \$1,000 (parts and labor) without pre-authorization.

-All boats will be bottom painted and have drive serviced and motor tuned to ensure a timely delivery.

-We must have all delivery information to schedule your spring launch date. Customers must meet us at ramp, we do not deliver to moorings

-Any boats left in storage will be charged a summer storage fee on July 1st.

-Account must be paid in full before boat leaves in spring (including fuel)

(TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONT'D)

1. No outside contractors are permitted on the premises without the prior authorization of the Marina. The services of sign painters, canvas repairs, electronics technicians and other required work can be arranged for by the Yard. It is important that we have control of all outside labor to ensure that they have adequate insurance for the protection of everyone. The possibility of lawsuits and/or fines against the yard means we cannot take lightly any infractions of this rule. Any damage caused by authorized subcontractors will be the sole responsibility of the owner who contracted the work. Owner will indemnify and hold harmless Hampton Watercraft & Marine for any injuries to property or person in connection with any work performed by individuals who are not Hampton Watercraft & Marine employees.

2. Owners are advised to leave a set of keys for their boat with the office in case of emergency. The Marina shall not be liable for fire, flood, abnormal high or low tides, theft, explosion, or water, snow or ice, freezing wind, vandalism, leakage, sinking, acts of God, or other damage to said vessel, its equipment, or any property in or on said vessel, however arising, except as a result of the direct, active negligence of the Marina. Winter storage customer shall save the Marina harmless from any such loss or damage and the Marina shall be under no obligation to insure the winter storage customer's boat, equipment or other property against any such loss or damage. Moreover, in the event of sinking, the customer shall act promptly to remove vessel from the Marina.

3. Owners shall advise Hampton Watercraft & Marine if boat is for sale. Should Hampton Watercraft & Marine consummate the sale, the following brokerage commission will be paid to Hampton Watercraft & Marine: on boats 0 - \$30,000 – approx. 20% commission, on boats \$30,001 - \$100,000 – approx. 15% commission, and on boats \$100,001 & over – approx. 10% commission. Should owner consummate sale on his/her own before listing the boat with Hampton Watercraft & Marine for sale, a fee of 3% of sale shall be paid to Hampton Watercraft & Marine. Outside brokers are not permitted in the Marina without express permission of Hampton Watercraft & Marine. Your signature hereon implies your acceptance of this policy.

4. The winter storage customer warrants that he owns the boat and that it is covered by his own separate boating policy, Winter storage customer shall be responsible for damage that he or his boat or equipment may cause to other boats in the Marina or to structures or facilities thereof.

5. The winter storage customer (and guests for whom he is responsible) agrees to conduct himself at all times when on the property of the Marina, so as to create no annoyance, hazard or nuisance to the Marina or to the other customers. This involves observance of good housekeeping and sanitation practices and the use of garbage receptacles and sanitation equipment.

6. Young children shall be accompanied by adults at all times.

7. The failure to make payments of all charges in accordance with this agreement shall create a lien upon the Owner's property in the amount of such default pursuant to the Lien Law of the State of New York. In the event of default by the Owner or other dispute, the Owner agrees to waive trial by jury and agrees to reimburse the Marina in full for any attorney's fees and/or other legal expenses incurred by reason of a breach of any of the provisions of the agreement.
